

# Princeton Review Partnership

#### Fall 2011 PSAT

The PSFA has established a partnership with The Princeton Review to offer classes at discounted rates to our students to help them prepare for college admissions testing. What does this mean? The Princeton Review test preparation service will provide free national testing days at our school with diagnostic results for each student.

PSAT classes will be offered for only \$99. Regular tuition for this program is \$299. This is a great opportunity for students who want to gain better insight into their strengths and weaknesses and also for those planning on taking these tests.

This fall we have planned a three-session PSAT preparation class for our sophomore and junior students that are scheduled to take the PSAT on October 12<sup>th</sup>. The cost of this class is \$75.
