

# From the Guidance Department...

SENIORS Mrs. Caruso and I have reviewed the college application process with all seniors. We explained how to get letters of recommendation, and what to do to after you submit your college applications using the CHS application checklist. Students were reminded that forms could be found in the Guidance Room of the BBS at the top of the page under SENIOR FORMS.

Application packets or requests for transcripts must be submitted a minimum of 10 working days prior to the application deadline.

This year we will be sending school documents electronically via Naviance again. If the college does not accept school documents (transcript, letters, profile) electronically they will be mailed. There is an application checklist for electronic submission and for submitting school documents through the mail on the guidance page. If you have any guestions about this process, do not hesitate to call.

• Regular college applications with a deadline past December 1: Application checklists should be submitted to the Guidance Office by <u>November 19<sup>th</sup></u>. • Applications with a December 1<sup>st</sup> deadline: Application checklists need to be in the office by

November 12<sup>th</sup>.

• For Early Decision or Early Action: Application checklists need to be in the Guidance Office at the latest by October 20<sup>th</sup>.

All scholarship information that comes to the Guidance Office is posted in the Guidance Room with either web links or applications.

Finally, the Fall SAT dates are November 5th, and December 3rd. Remember YOU MUST SEND SAT SCORES DIRECTLY TO THE COLLEGES. Now you have score choice, so you do not have to send all of the scores, but you must send complete sets from individual test dates. Each time you take the test, you receive four free reports. If your child is signed up for the SATs, make sure that their best scores are sent to all of the colleges where they are applying. For more information visit sat.collegeboard.org.

JUNIORS will take the PSATs on Wednesday October 12<sup>th</sup>. There are no make-up test days for the PSATs. This test is used to determine National Merit Scholarship finalists.

There are many college representatives coming to visit our school this year. Most visits are scheduled in October and November and are listed on the calendar. The representative will have a table in the cafeteria and can answer questions about their school and its programs. Also, check the Guidance Room for college Open Houses and Information Sessions.

SOPHOMORES will take the PSATs on Wednesday, October 12th as well. This administration is for practice and will not impact future scholarship eligibility. Encourage your children to be involved in activities both in school and in the community if they plan to apply for National Honor Society next year.

FRESHMEN will be meeting with their guidance counselors and will be encouraged to join activities at CHS. The guidelines for the National Honor Society are explained and activities, both in school and in the community, are part of the requirements. The CHS Student Handbook gives a wonderful explanation. Also, encourage your children to take advantage of the extra help offered by their teachers during the lunch and activity hour.
