The 2014-2015 school year is off and running. We thank our parents and students for an excellent start to a new school year.

Seniors: Our seniors have begun the college application process. Please visit our blog and click on the tab *Common Questions About the Common Application*. While you're there, check out the *Local Scholarships* tab. We're trying hard to give our blog a user-friendly feel! Feedback is appreciated.

Here are a few helpful reminders for seniors:

- Put your colleges in Naviance under Colleges I'm Applying To. Remember to maintain this list, as we will generate midyear reports from this information.
- Sign your FERPA waiver and match your Naviance account to your Common Application.
- If you haven't already done so, ask your teachers for letters of recommendation.
- When you are ready for us to send your supporting documentation (transcript, school profile, and letters of recommendation), fill out an Application Check List and hand it to your counselor.
- SAT and ACT scores are to be sent directly to the college from the testing organization.

Parents, we realize this may be a stressful time and we encourage you to make an appointment if you would like to discuss any individual concerns. Remember, applying to college is a process, not an exact science. Although some steps through the process may be predictable, each college is unique in its requirements and deadlines.

Sophomores and juniors: This is a time of testing and college exploration for you. The Monmouth County College fair at Brookdale Community College is on October 5th, 2014; please try to attend. Visit the blog for more information and a link to a list of attending colleges. Don't forget to print labels with your child's name, address, year of high school graduation, and email address. It's a real time saver!

Juniors: We will be setting up individual parent meetings in November, and we look forward to working with you and your child as we begin his or her post-secondary journey together.

Juniors, sophomores, and freshman: The PSAT will be administered on October 15th, here at CHS. In addition to possible recognition in the National Merit Scholarship program (Juniors only), these are some of the benefits of taking the PSAT:

My College QuickStart is an online college and career planning kit available free of charge to all students who took the PSAT/NMSQT. It is powered by their responses to the test and provides personalized information that helps students take their next steps toward college:

My Online Score Report—an enhanced score report that allows students to review each test question, their answers, and the correct answers with answer explanations

My SAT Study Plan—a customized SAT study plan based on students' PSAT/NMSQT test performance, highlighting skills for review and practice

My Personality—a detailed personality test that helps students learn about themselves and discover majors and careers that fit their strengths and interests

My Major & Career Matches—extensive information about majors and careers, including insights about what to expect and what courses to take now

My College Matches—a starter list of colleges based on students’ home state and indicated choice of major

Results will be available in December and students will need their access code, which is printed on the paper score report, and these tools can be used throughout high school. Using My College QuickStart (in addition to Naviance) together with your child is a great way to introduce and guide your child through important aspects of the college-going process. Visit www.collegeboard.com/quickstart.

DEFENSIVE DRIVING CLASS STARTS IN JANUARY

Just Rite Driving School (<http://bit.ly/justritedrivingschool>) will offer a 30-hour Defensive Driving classroom course at CHS beginning January 7th, 2015. The cost is \$150 and may be paid by check on the first day or in advance via a credit card. Students 15 years of age & older are encouraged to register. Classes will be held on 10 consecutive Wednesdays (weather permitting) from 2:30-5:30pm*. Parents of enrolled students will be required to take turns chaperoning; a schedule will be set prior to the first class.

Bob, the instructor, will cover a basic introduction to driving, defensive driving strategies & Motor Vehicle rules & regulations. Many insurance companies offer a discount for this course; please check with your provider. Just Rite Driving School also offers Behind-the-Wheel instruction at a special rate for students enrolled in both programs.

Upon successful completion of the State of NJ Motor Vehicle test given at the end of the course, a test waiver card will be issued, eliminating the need to be tested at the DMV. (For 15-year-old students, Just Rite Driving will retain the waiver card until their 16th birthday is reached.)
